The Governance Cycle in Parliamentary Democracies

Michael Laver is Professor Emeritus of Politics in the NYU Department of Politics and Visiting Professor in the Department of Methodology at the London School of Economics and Political Science. His research interests include analytical, computational and empirical accounts of political competition and decision-making.

Governance in parliamentary democracies is a never ending cycle of elections, government formation, government survival, and ultimately more elections. This complex system is analytically intractable using traditional formal methods, but computationally tractable using agent-based models and artificial intelligence.
