


Failed exams can be repeated **as often as desired** until the maximum duration of study is reached.




Grading

# **Compulsory registration?** There is **no** compulsory registration for (failed) exams. → register yourself!

Improvement?

Passed exams **cannot** be repeated.

Illness

in case of illness, a **medical certificate must be submitted** to the examination office, otherwise the exam is considered a failed attempt.

Each semester, the **semester fee** (118.60€) must be transferred for re-registration for the next semester.

the bookings usually take place **before the start** of the semester and many sports are full very quickly.




### **Course Registration**





General Examination Regulations ("allgemeine Prüfungsordnung")

- Examination regulations for the entire faculty WIAI
- Basic framework conditions of the study programme

Study and Examination Regulations ("Studien- und Fachprüfungsordnung")

 Course-specific regulations such as duration of study, stay abroad, modules to be taken and learning objectives

### Module Handbook ("Modulhandbuch")

- Exact breakdown of the modules to be taken
- Most frequently needed to plan your studies

## Typical types of events



#### Lecture

- Biggest event
- Mostly with the Professor himself
- Teaching the theory

#### Exercise

- Applying the theory from the lecture
- Often in smaller groups
- New, more practical content also possible

### Tutorial

#### • No new content

 Student tutor answers questions and you work on additional exercises


## University events and timetable creation
