The lectures should take about 30 minutes. Afterwards will be some time for discussion. The lectures should introduce into the topic and the central questions, methodical and technical issues, such as problems appearing in the working process. The language of the lectures is to be German or English.

Accommodation of participants and guests will, as far as possible, be provided by fellow students in Bamberg.

For the lecturers we will provide a support of maximum 100 € for travelling expenses.


Interested guests are asked to register themselves until 2009-05-25, so we can try to offer a lodging possibility.
