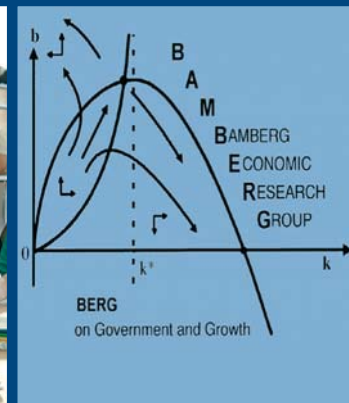

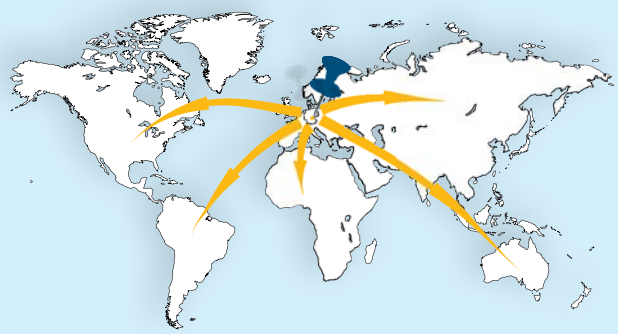


## The Bachelor and Master Program European Economic Studies (EES)

The core curriculum of EES focuses on the field of economics while incorporating a European dimension through internationality and interdisciplinarity. Complementary modules in the field of languages and social sciences – partly obligatory, partly optional – and studies abroad allow students to gain outstanding expertise in the field of economics as well as to develop their very individual academic profile.

### Partner Universities

The University of Bamberg offers more than 200 exchange programs in almost 60 countries.



## Bachelor Program (2+1 years)

- Acquisition of **economic core competences** in macroeconomics, microeconomics and econometrics
- **Multidisciplinary** approach covering related disciplines such as business administration, law and sociology
- **Internationality** through training in two foreign business languages and integrated academic year abroad
- First academic degree, **Bachelor of Science (BSc) in European Economic Studies (EES)**, after three years of study

### Main Subjects in the Program

- Economics (academic core subject)
- Econometrics and complementary applied methods
- Two foreign business languages
- Complementary subjects (business studies, law, optional subjects)

### Academic Year Abroad

A year of study at a foreign university

### Obligatory Internship

Six weeks

### Bachelor Thesis

To be completed within six weeks following the foreign study period



## Master Program (2 years)

- **Distinct alignment** with the targeted field of occupation through specialization
- Training in **two foreign business languages**
- **Flexibility and multidisciplinary** through choice of supplementary modules
- Degree of **Master of Science (MSc) in European Economic Studies (EES)**



### Required Subjects

- Advanced Microeconomics
- Advanced Macroeconomics
- Dynamics, Stability and Optimization
- Econometrics

### Compulsory Electives

Fields of specialization include:

- **International Economics** with a focus on Foreign Trade and Financial Markets
- **Economic Policy** with a focus on Public Finance, Labor Markets and Social Policy
- **Behavioral Economics** with a focus on Behavioral Finance and Industrial Economics

### Master Thesis

To be completed within a three-month period during the fourth semester at Bamberg University
