Second attempt

Failed exams can be repeated **as often as desired** until the maximum duration of study is reached.



Registration deadlines for examinations are **binding** (same for de-registration).

Examinations



Compulsory registration? There is **no** compulsory registration for (failed) exams.
→ register yourself!

Improvement? Passed exams **cannot** be repeated.

Illness in case of illness, a **medical certificate must be submitted** to the examination office, otherwise the exam is considered a failed attempt.

Each semester, the **semester fee** (118.60€) must be transferred for re-registration for the next semester.

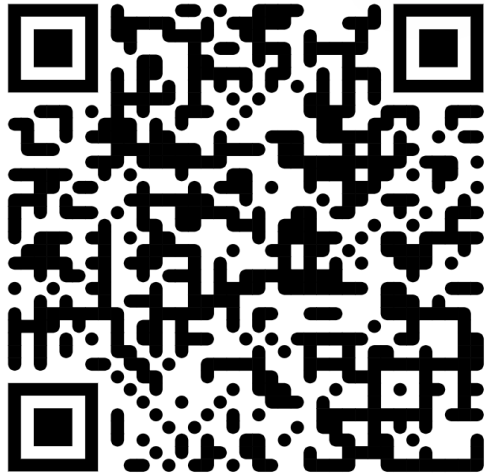
for some courses, especially language courses, a **speedy** registration is expected. (first registration deadlines for languages did end on 08.04.2024)

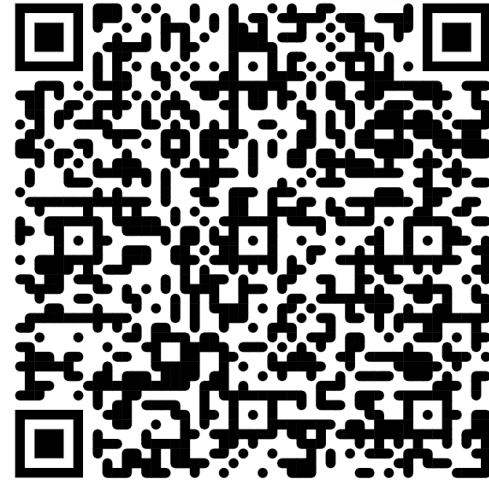

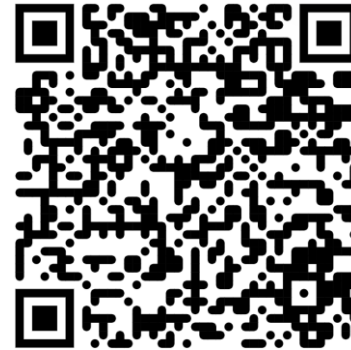

General Examination Regulations („allgemeine Prüfungsordnung“)

- Examination regulations for the entire faculty WIAI
- Basic framework conditions of the study programme

Study and Examination Regulations („Studien- und Fachprüfungsordnung“)

- Course-specific regulations such as duration of study, stay abroad, modules to be taken and learning objectives

Module Handbook („Modulhandbuch“)

- Exact breakdown of the modules to be taken
- Most frequently needed to plan your studies

Typical types of events



Lecture

- Biggest event
- Mostly with the Professor himself
- Teaching the theory

Exercise

- Applying the theory from the lecture
- Often in smaller groups
- New, more practical content also possible

Tutorial

- No new content
- Student tutor answers questions and you work on additional exercises

University events and timetable creation



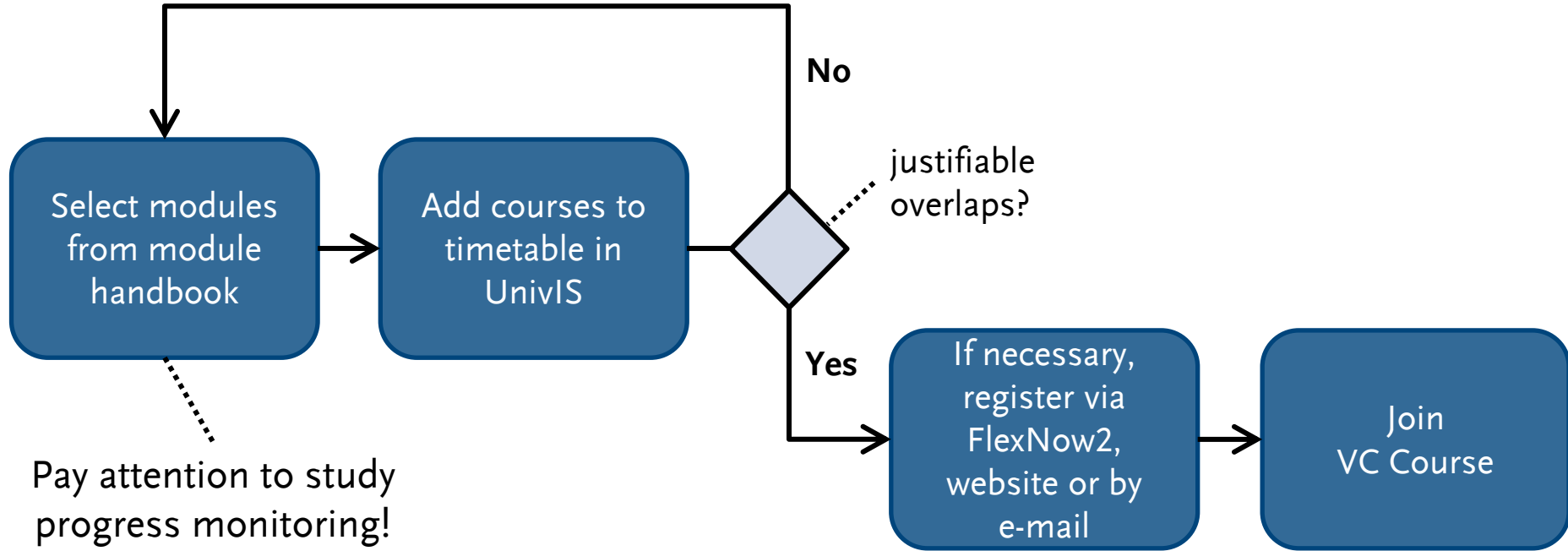
At the university you are **not given any timetables**, you can choose your own module.

Caution: Events usually take place "c.t.". "14 o'clock" means, for example, that the start is at 14:15. (Opposite: "s.t.": 2 pm = 2:00 pm)
