



The Faculty of Human Sciences and Education invites applications for the position of

Professor (W 3 salary level) of
Clinical Child and Adolescent Psychology

tenured civil servant to be filled as of winter semester (October 1 2021).

The candidate for the position is expected to represent the field of Clinical Child and Adolescent Psychology (basic principles, clinical applications) in research and teaching.

Participation will be expected in the B.Sc. and M. Sc. degree programmes “Psychology” as well as in the teacher training programme for elementary education “School Psychology”. In addition, we expect the successful candidate to actively contribute to implementing a new curriculum in Clinical Psychology and Psychotherapy (‘Approbationsstudium’) which is currently reformed in Germany and planned to start at the University of Bamberg in the winter semester 2022/23. The candidate will be expected to strengthen the programme of practical teaching courses. A board certification (‘Approbation’) as child and adolescent psychotherapist is requested; an active involvement in the Outpatient Centre for Psychotherapy affiliated to the Department of Clinical Psychology and Psychotherapy is possible. Regarding research, connectivity with the fields of research of the Institute of Psychology is desired.

In addition, the successful candidate is also expected to take on duties in the area of academic self-government and to the Faculty’s international exchange programmes.

The relevant qualifications consist of a completed academic degree, pedagogical aptitude, a particular talent for academic work generally substantiated by the quality of a doctorate, and, in addition to this, further academic achievements. Additional academic credentials must be certified by a Habilitation or equivalent academic qualification, which may also have been obtained through activities outside of higher education or within the scope of an assistant professorship.

Concerning tenured positions as a civil servant (“Beamtenverhältnis”), the candidate must be under the age of 52 years at the time of appointment (for exceptional cases see Art. 10 Abs. 3 Satz 2 BayHSchPG).

The Faculty is an equal opportunity employer and encourages applications from female candidates. Where candidates are otherwise equally qualified, preference will be given to candidates with disabilities.
