



The Faculty of Human Sciences and Education at the University of Bamberg invites applications for the position of

Assistant Professor (W 1 tenure track W 2 salary level) of Health Psychology (m/w/d)

as a limited-tenure civil servant starting from October 2022. Following a positive evaluation conducted at the University of Bamberg after six years, the successful candidate's position will be commuted to a fully tenured W 2 professorship without a public call for additional applications. This tenure-track professorship is sponsored by the German Federal Government-Länder Tenure-Track Programme.

The successful candidate will be responsible for the following:

The holder of the post is expected to contribute to research on health psychology, i.e., behavior, cognition, emotion, and motivation within the context of diseases, health risks, and preventive measures. Research should be interdisciplinary and focus on basic and applied research topics.

Teaching should cover the content of health psychology for the Bachelor's and Master's degree programmes in Psychology. In the Master's degree, the holder of the post should teach specializations of health psychology as well as courses on health promotion in several basic and applied subjects of the Master's degree in psychology.

In addition, the successful candidate is also expected to be involved in contributing to the internationalisation of the Faculty's course offering, to support its international cooperation and exchange programmes, and take on duties in the area of academic self-government.

The relevant qualifications consist of a completed academic degree, pedagogical aptitude, and a particular talent for academic work generally substantiated by the quality of the candidate's doctoral degree. Applicants for the tenure track professorship are desired having changed universities after completing their doctorate or having researched outside of Bamberg University for at least two years.

The selection process shall be conducted according to the provisions of the *Bayerisches Hochschulpersonalgesetz* (Bavarian Higher Education Employment Act) concerning the appointment of professors and assistant professors (Art. 18)) as well as the rules of the Otto Friedrich University Bamberg for regulating the procedure regarding flexible appeal options. If the general employment requirements are met, the selected candidate will be employed as a limited-tenure civil servant for an initial period of three years. Following a positive evaluation, a further three-year extension is intended.

The Faculty is an equal opportunity employer and encourages applications from female candidates. Where candidates are otherwise equally qualified, preference will be given to candidates with disabilities.

The University of Bamberg has been certified by the Hertie Foundation as a family-friendly university and is committed to taking measures to help reconcile work and family life. The university is committed to promoting gender equality in the workplace.
