The course aims at introducing participants to the specificities of virtual presentations and lectures as well as to the use of web-conference tools. Participants will learn to use technical tools effectively, to communicate, present and lecture in the virtual space, to keep the interest and the attention of the audience alive and to handle questions and virtual discussions. Moreover, copyright issues will be clarified and relevant questions will be answered. The second day, a mini conference will be simulated, in which participants will have the opportunity to give short presentations and receive feedback. The webinar language is English.

The workshop is mainly aimed at doctoral students, regular and associated members of BAGSS and LifBi. In case of any vacant places, it is open to anyone interested.
