### Short Outline

Third party funding is playing an increasingly important role in research funding from universities. A key funding instrument in Germany are the research grants of the German Research Foundation (DFG), particularly the “Research Grants Programme” (Sachbeihilfe). This enables all persons with completed scientific training (completed doctorate) to carry out a single, thematically and temporally limited research project.

In this introductory course, the funding portfolio of the DFG, the application and the calculation of DFG projects are presented. The focus is on the funding format “Research Grants Programme” (Sachbeihilfe).

The workshop is mainly aimed at Doctoral students who are about to graduate, postdocs, and scientific staff (humanities and social sciences)
