Short Outline

As social science researchers, you are constantly confronted with disagreements and opposing arguments. Especially in important and complex issues such as gender related topics, it is essential to exchange arguments in a professional way and as social scientists, we are held to a high standard. Debating these issues accordingly, reminds us to reflect our way of thinking and sensitizes us for different perspectives.

Within this workshop, the participants will learn how to find and build coherent and convincing arguments as well as refuting solid counterarguments. By explaining the advantages and disadvantages of a topic, a high analytical depth is achieved in argumentation, which helps participants to voice their opinions in daily life. The workshop will also cover how to present oneself in a self-confident manner, even if the audience is a discerning one and will show ways how to handle interruptions and faultfinding questions. At the end, the seminar participants will conduct an exercise debate prepared during the training.

The workshop is mainly aimed at doctoral students and postdoctoral researchers of BAGSS. In case of any vacant places, it is open to anyone interested.
