Short Description:

The seminar introduces students to political science and presents the basic academic skills necessary to succeed in the education itinerary in political science. The course content retraces the course “Grundlagen politikwissenschaftlichen Arbeitens” but the course is held in English and we will use literature in English.

During the course, students will learn how to systematically search for scientific resources, and how to properly cite them. Students will also learn tools to efficiently structure and write presentations and papers, including standards and good practices in scientific research. We will also examine how to pose and independently develop relevant research questions for research in political science. Through examples, students will get a grip on these fundamentals, and acquire the ability to minimally understand the logic of scientific argumentation. Additionally, students will be introduced to the main concepts of political science, as well as to the arrangement of the Department of Political Science at Bamberg University.
