## Grading

✗ At 5.0 you have failed

## Second attempt

Failed exams can be repeated **as often as desired** until the maximum duration of study is reached.



**Registration** deadlines for examinations are **binding** (same for de-registration).

# Examinations



**Compulsory registration?** There is **no** compulsory registration for (failed) exams.  
→ register yourself!

**Improvement?** Passed exams **cannot** be repeated.

**Illness** in case of illness, a **medical certificate must be submitted** to the examination office, otherwise the exam is considered a failed attempt.

## Re-registration

Each semester, the **semester fee** (123.22€) must be transferred for re-registration for the next semester.

## Course Registration

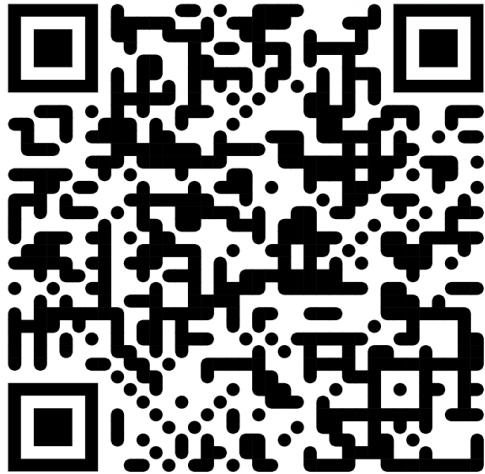
for some courses, especially language courses, a **speedy** registration is expected. (first registration deadlines for languages did end on 02.04.2026)

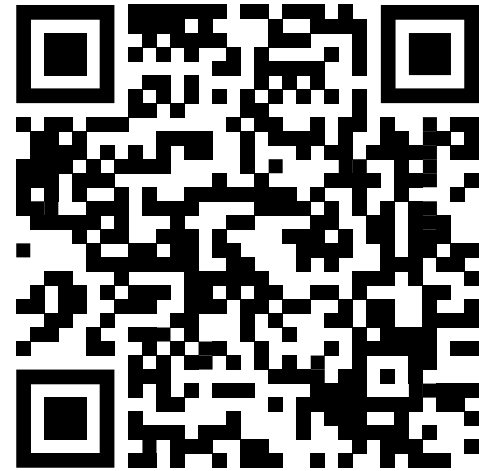

# University events and timetable creation



## General Examination Regulations („allgemeine Prüfungsordnung“)

- Examination regulations for the entire faculty WIAI
- Basic framework conditions of the study programme

## Study and Examination Regulations („Studien- und Fachprüfungsordnung“)

- Course-specific regulations such as duration of study, stay abroad, modules to be taken and learning objectives

## Module Handbook („Modulhandbuch“)

- Exact breakdown of the modules to be taken
- Most frequently needed to plan your studies

# Typical types of events



## Lecture

- Biggest event
- Mostly with the Professor himself
- Teaching the theory

## Exercise

- Applying the theory from the lecture
- Often in smaller groups
- New, more practical content also possible

## Tutorial

- No new content
- Student tutor answers questions and you work on additional exercises

# University events and timetable creation



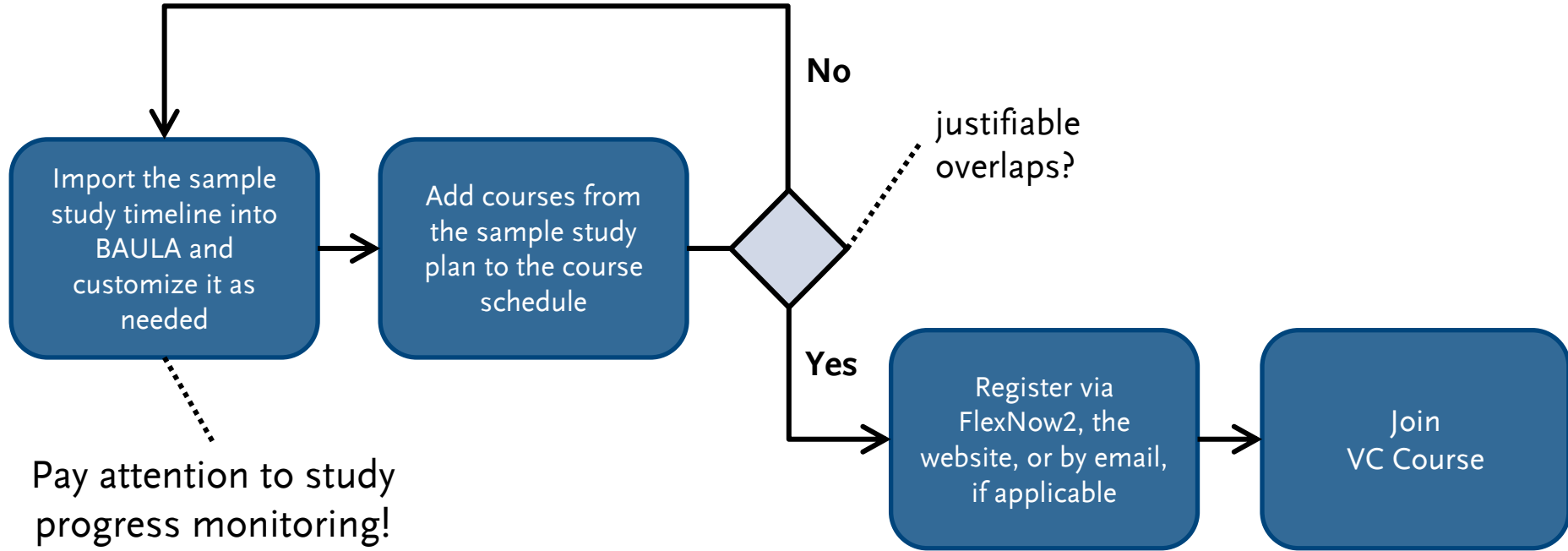
At the university you are **not given any timetables**, you can choose your own module.

For orientation, you will find **sample timetables** for this semester in the freshman brochures for many degrees.



**Caution:** Events usually take place "c.t.". "14 o'clock" means, for example, that the start is at 14:15. (Opposite: "s.t.": 2 pm = 2:00 pm)
