




# Important terms, deadlines and information

At 5.0 you have failed

Second attempt

Failed exams can be repeated **as often as desired** until the maximum duration of study is reached.



**Registration** deadlines for examinations are **binding** (same for de-registration).

#### **Examinations**



**Compulsory registration?** There is **no** compulsory registration for

(failed) exams.

→ register yourself!

**Improvement?** Passed exams **cannot** be repeated.

Illness in case of illness, a medical certificate must be

submitted to the examination office, otherwise

the exam is considered a failed attempt.

#### **Re-registration**

Each semester, the **semester fee** (118.60€) must be transferred for re-registration for the next semester.



- Basic framework conditions of the study programme

#### Study and Examination Regulations ("Studien- und Fachprüfungsordnung")

 Course-specific regulations such as duration of study, stay abroad, modules to be taken and learning objectives

### Module Handbook ("Modulhandbuch")

- Exact breakdown of the modules to be taken
- Most frequently needed to plan your studies

- Mostly with the Professor himself
- Teaching the theory

#### Exercise

- Applying the theory from the lecture
- Often in smaller groups
- New, more practical content also possible

At the university you are **not given any timetables**, you can choose your own module.


For orientation, you will find **sample timetables** for this semester in the freshman brochures for many degrees.
