



Inhalt
The objective of this lecture is to provide students with a comprehensive understanding of the financial situation of private households and the various opportunities for building, managing, and safeguarding personal wealth over the life cycle. The course emphasizes the importance of incorporating financial considerations into individual decision-making processes throughout life. Students acquire practical and readily applicable tools for the organization of household finances and for making informed financial decisions.

The course offers a structured overview of financial products available to private investors and explains the functioning of financial markets from a market microstructure perspective. It introduces the key criteria relevant to financial planning and demonstrates how to develop a coherent investment strategy. Particular emphasis is placed on the analysis and evaluation of major investment instruments, including fixed-income securities, equity investments, active and passive investment funds, exchange-traded funds (ETFs), and real estate investments for both personal use and investment purposes. The benefits and risks associated with these instruments are systematically examined.

By combining theoretical foundations with practical applications, the course equips students—even those with limited prior knowledge—with the competencies required to make informed and responsible financial decisions. Upon completion of the course, students will be familiar with the typical challenges faced by private households in the context of financial planning and will be able to assess the long-term implications of financial decisions across different stages of life.

The course addresses the following topics:

- Macroeconomic indicators relevant to private households
- Financial planning and household budgeting
- Commercial paper and short-term financial instruments
- Fixed-income securities
- Equity investments
- Investment funds and related financial products
- Insurance products and risk management
- Real estate as an asset class



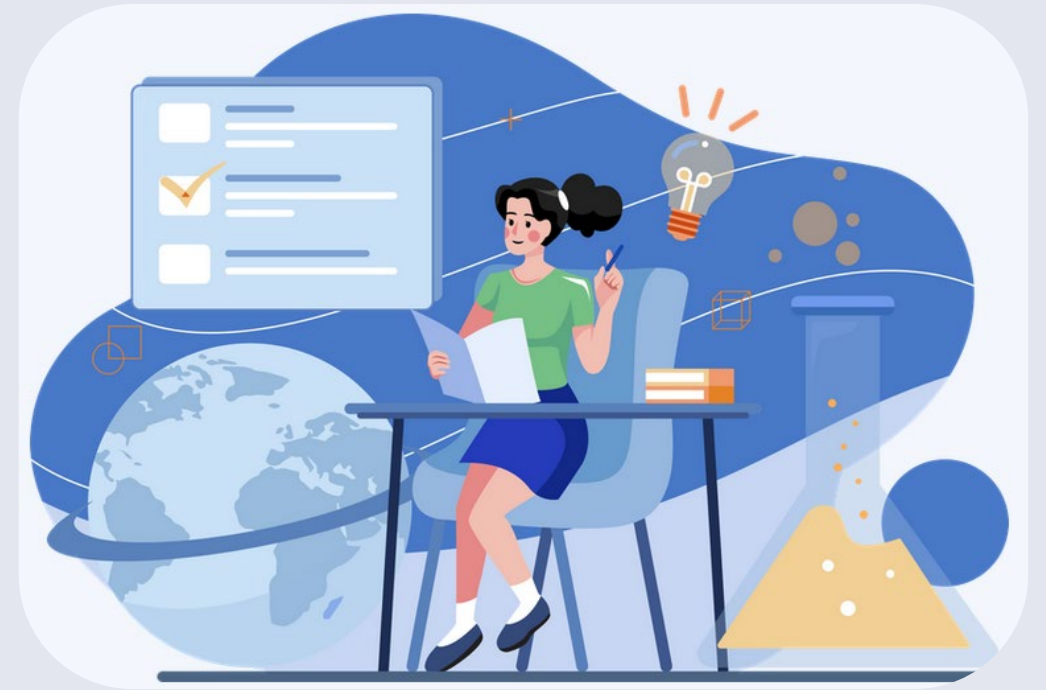

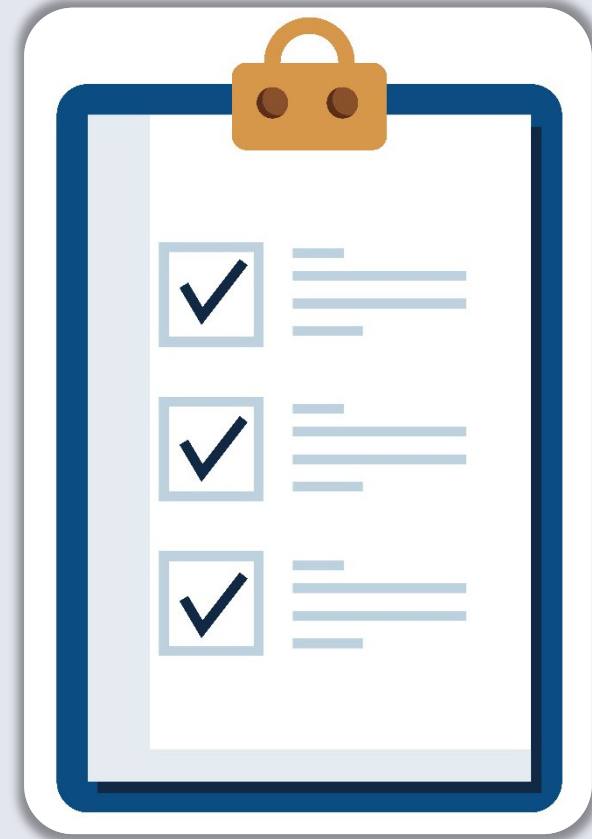

- 2 physical copies of ToR to your home university

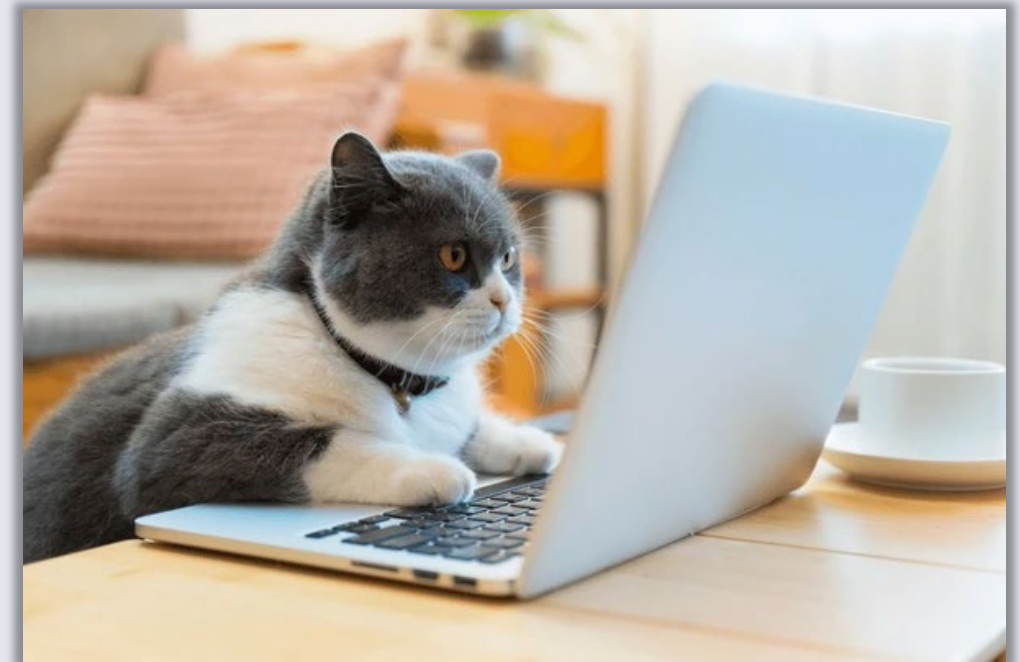
