Navigating Loneliness: Experiences of First-Generation Older Migrants in the Netherlands and Young International Students in Germany

Prof. Dr. Başak Bilecen is Professor of Sociology at the University of Groningen, the Netherlands. Since 2023, she is the chair of the Dutch Association for Migration Research. In 2022, she was awarded the Karl Arnold Prize by the NRW Academy of Sciences and Arts for her lifetime achievements in migration scholarship. In 2017-2018, she was John F. Kennedy Memorial Fellow at the Center for European Studies, Harvard University.

Her work focuses on international migration, transnationality, social protection, social networks, and social inequalities which appeared in leading international journals including *Social Networks*, *Journal of Ethnic and Migration Studies*, *Population, Space, and Place*, and *The Gerontologist*.
