

Setting up Wi-Fi for Android (eduroam)

Important information:

- You need an active internet connection to install eduroam, e.g. via the free **@BayernWLAN** or mobile data.
- Important:** If you have previously connected to eduroam via eduroamCAT or manually, you must delete the old configuration before following these instructions. To find out how to delete the previous settings, go to www.uni-bamberg.de/its/eduroam.
- To access the wireless network of the University of Bamberg, you need a **valid user account (BA number + password)**.
- Members of other universities or research institutions** participating in eduroam (DFN roaming) can also use the eduroam network at the University of Bamberg. If you are unable to log in, please contact your home institution for information on the specifics of using eduroam.
- This manual is for Android 10 and later versions.**

Attention: You must use the **easyroam** app to obtain a stable and secure connection to the Wi-Fi with the eduroam SSID.

1 Setup with easyroam

1.1 Install easyroam

Download and install the **easyroam** app from the Google Play Store.

1.2 Setting up easyroam

Once you have opened the application, tap **Login through Website**. Enter Bamberg in the search field and select Bamberg University.




Figure 2: Choose **Universität Bamberg**

Enter your **BA-number** and password into the Shibboleth-Login. On the next page, read and accept the consent form. On the following page, read the privacy statement and submit your data.

Now tap **Install new profile** on the easyroam app home screen. Confirm the pop-up to create the profile and allow the Wi-Fi suggested by easyroam.

Once the profile is set up, you can close the app.




Figure 4: **Eduroam setup complete**
