MAEES2 Foreign Business Language:

In the module group MAEES2 "Foreign Business Language", modules of a foreign business language or basic language modules with a total of 12 ECTS credits must be completed. In the business languages two modules of one of the following languages are to be chosen:

- Business English (12 ECTS)
- Business French (12 ECTS)
- Business Italian (12 ECTS)
- Business Spanish (12 ECTS)

Business German can only be chosen by students who have not acquired their university entrance qualification in German, provided that the examination board has approved an application in this regard.

MAEES Specialisation: Economic Theory and Methods:

Student who did not complete at least one course in International Economics and Economic Policy in their bachelor's select at least one module from MAEES3 and at least one module from MAEES6 during the first year in Bamberg.

Students who want to select International Political Economy in Nijmegen must additionally prove that they completed 18 ECTS in Political Science during their Bachelor.
