

# Funding of Academic Conference Participations of Doctoral Candidates from the University of Bamberg

In the context of IPID4all, the line of funding **Academic Conference Participation Abroad (max. 5 days)** for doctoral students from the University of Bamberg will be extended from 1 November 2017 to 30 June 2019.

The funding for 2019 is announced in May 2018. The selection of the applications will be carried out by an interfaculty panel. The earliest start of funding is January 2019.

## Please note:

In order to provide all-year funding of academic conference participations, you will be able to hand in your application **at two dates**. <u>Submission deadlines are</u>

31 October 2018: for a conference taking place between 1 January and 31 March, 2019

**31 January 2019:** for a conference taking place between 1 April and June 30, 2019

If you are not able to verify the active participation at the conference at the time of application, please hand in all of the preliminary documents available as well as official information on the conference (e.g. conference program/ link to webpage).

The awarding of mobility grants by the panel will be provided under reserve until the submission of the official verification.

## **Target Group**

All doctoral students who have a first supervisor at the University of Bamberg and who are listed in the doctoral students' database are eligible candidates.

Furthermore, scholarship recipients are eligible, if the requested funding is not covered by the original scholarship.

# Type of support

Depending on the country of origin and the duration of the stay, travel and accommodation expenses will be covered in accordance with the IPID4all travel allowance (see <u>travel</u> and <u>accommodation allowance</u>).



# Documents for Application (max. 12 pages)

- cover letter (max. 3 pages) with the following information:
  - o country and city of destination
  - start and duration of the stay (dates)
  - o explanation of the relevance of the stay to your doctoral research project
  - o brief description of the doctoral research project
- expert opinion of the first doctoral supervisor
- CV
- so far as already available: verification of active participation (e.g. excerpt form a conference program which includes your name and contribution/ invitation from the organizer/ confirmation of the acceptance of your paper)
- official information on the conference (e.g. conference program/ link to webpage).

### **Submission Deadline**

For the first submission deadline, please **submit your application documents** (in German or English) **in duplicate** to Ms. Simone Treiber (An der Weberei 5, 96047 Bamberg, Room WE5/04.113) by no later than **31 October 2018**. Please send an additional PDF file (one document) to <u>ipid4all.trac(at)uni-bamberg.de</u>.
