APPENDIX A - BAMBERG

Double degree program between the University of Pavia (Master in Economics, Finance and Integration (MEFI) and Master in International Business and Entrepreneurship (MIBE)) and the University of Bamberg (Master in Business Administration and Master in Finance and Accounting).

1. General Information

Students of both institutions start in the winter semester at the home university and complete the first year of the program there. In the second year, students move to the host university. **Bamberg students** of the Master in Finance and Accounting go to the Master in Economics, Finance and Integration (MEFI) and students of the Master in Betriebswirtschaftslehre go to the Master in International Business and Entrepreneurship (MIBE). The following tables define the overall structure of the double degree program.
