APPENDIX A - PAVIA

Double degree program between the University of Pavia (Master in Economics, Finance and Integration, MEFI, Master in International Business and Entrepreneurship, MIBE and Master Economia e legislazione d'impresa, MELI) and the University of Bamberg (Master in Business Administration and Master in Finance and Accounting).

1. General Information

Students of both institutions start in the winter semester at the home university and complete the first year of the program there. In the second year, students move to the host university. **Pavia students** of the Master in Economics, Finance and Integration (MEFI) go to the Master in Finance and Accounting and students of the Master in International Business and Entrepreneurship (MIBE) go to the Master in Betriebswirtschaftslehre. The following tables define the overall structure of the double degree program.
