Interdisciplinary Studies in Economics with an Integrated Year Abroad

In the 2000/01 winter semester, the University of Bamberg established the bachelor's degree in European Economic Studies (EES) – the first consecutive-model bachelor's degree programme in economics in Bavaria (and one of the first of its kind in Germany). 2005 saw the accreditation of the programme by the ACQUIN accreditation agency, and in 2012 the programme was successfully reaccredited.

At the core of the curriculum is the study of economics, a discipline focused on describing and explaining both micro and macroeconomic phenomena.

In the EES degree programme, our top priorities are internationality (with an explicitly European focus) and interdisciplinarity.

By way of business-specific instruction in **two foreign languages**, an **integrated year abroad** and the incorporation of the faculty's wide-ranging economic and socioscientific course offering, students not only develop advanced expertise in economics, but can also develop an individualized academic profile.

Your Studies

Fundamental economic and methodological principles are presented not only in lecture courses on macroeconomics, microeconomics and statistics, but also in smaller seminars on topics like "Current Issues in European Economic Policy." The languages of instruction in the EES bachelor's programme are German and English.

Furthermore, students may also attend courses in subject fields like business administration and management, political science, business informatics, law and sociology. This broad selection of subjects and courses means that the EES bachelor's programme affords students a high degree of flexibility in their studies.

The University of Bamberg's faculty of Social Sciences, Economics and Business Administration awards the "Bachelor of Science (BSc)" degree for successful completion of the programme. Depending on the institution at which students study during their year abroad, degrees from both the University of Bamberg and the foreign university may be possible.
