

### Your future

As an MA graduate, you will possess in-depth knowledge of the English language and a high linguistic competence — in speaking as well as in writing. You will be able to independently and critically assess and analyse texts and other cultural artefacts and you will also be trained in describing and evaluating cultural phenomena and structures, using a sophisticated set of theories and methods. You will be familiar with anglophone cultures and have skills that enable you to work in jobs that focus on cultural mediation and international communication.

Among your future professional areas are publishing houses, literary institutions and cultural organisations. You may work in journalism, PR or marketing, in adult education or tourism. Good or very good MA graduates may continue their academic career by enrolling for a PhD programme and joining the Bamberg Graduate School of Literary, Cultural and Media Studies (BaGraLCM).



#### Requirements

- BA in English and American Studies or a corresponding university degree that contains 45 or more ECTS obtained in English and American Studies.
- high proficiency in English, accounted for by one of the established language certificates (TOEFL: 100 (online test); 250 (computer-based); 600 (paper) or higher; IELTS: 7.0 or higher; Cambridge Proficieny Exam: A)



# English and American Studies in Bamberg

The MA programme "English and American Studies" gives you the opportunity to study in depth the languages, literatures and cultures of the anglophone world.

You cover four areas of study – linguistics, literary and cultural studies and language proficiency. You thus gain a diverse and indepth knowledge of the English language, its structures as well as its varieties throughout anglophone cultures.

Apart from a focus on interdisciplinary research and cultural studies, our programme concentrates on the historical development of the English language, its literatures and cultures.

With more than 250 partner universities in 60 countries, the University of Bamberg is an international one. You will be encouraged to study one semester abroad, ideally in one of our partner universities in the UK, the USA, Canada or Australia.

At Bamberg, you will study in a versatile programme that trains your academic, communicative and cultural competence, preparing you for a variety of different professions.

### Programme Structure

Three master modules in the areas of linguistics, literary studies and cultural studies are the backbone for all subsequent courses. Later, you have the opportunity to focus on either one or two of these areas of study.

The language proficiency courses are meant to improve your reading, writing and speaking skills in English.

Additionally, you can take courses from another subject of your choice taught at the University of Bamberg.

### Special Programme: European Joint Master's Degree

The European Joint Master's Degree in English and American Studies is an international degree issued by Bamberg and five other universities in Graz, New York, Paris, Pécs and Venice.

The universities in the consortium work together to provide a high quality international curriculum with regional aspects. Students that choose this programme study one semester at one of the partner university.

After successful completion of the full programme students will be awarded the joint MA degree of the six core members of the consortium identifying the corresponding equivalent per country, and receive a diploma supplement. For this degree, special application requirements apply.
