

Submission Guidelines:

Important! Submissions that do not follow the following guidelines will not be considered.

1. What kind of submissions do we accept?

Please submit only **previously unpublished pieces and pieces that relate to our current edition's topic.** You can find the current topic on our [uni page](#), on every call for submission flyer and in our social media posts.

We only accept submission that have reached us until our deadline. You can find the deadline with the topic.

2. What length should my submission have?

For **creative prose** submissions (fiction or nonfiction), please submit one piece (short story or essay) between 500 and 2,000 words.

For **poetry** submissions, please submit one poem. If the poem has subsections, mark them clearly in your document. A poem should not exceed four pages in length.

For **comic** submissions, please submit one comic in a maximum of 12 frames and in high resolution in a single **pdf** file.

3. How can I submit my work?

Provide your submission with a **title page**. Your title page should include your full name, a short bio (e.g. with your age, hobbies etc.), your first and second language(s), the category of your piece (prose, poetry, creative creation), title of your piece, contact information (email) and the day of your submission. Put page numbers on all following pages.

Your submission must reach us before the deadline.

We prefer **doc** and **docx** files. In case your submissions requires special formatting, we also accept **pdf** files.

4. Can I submit something that I've sent to another publisher if it hasn't been accepted there yet?

Yes, but please tell us that you've sent your writing to another publisher and contact us if you decide to go with them rather than with us. We cannot publish your work if it is being published elsewhere.

5. Where can I turn to if I still have questions?

If you still have questions, don't hesitate to send us an [email](#)! You can write us in English and in German. We usually only take a day or two to answer.

6. I've submitted a piece. What now?

Congratulations! There's nothing for you to do now but wait. Our editors will read all submitted writings after the end of the deadline. This may take some time. Please allow a period of 30 days after the deadline. We will then contact you if your writing has made the cut and will be published in our magazine. More information on publication will be provided in a private mail.
