

# The University of Bamberg

The University of Bamberg is both the newest and one of the oldest universities in Bavaria. In the 17th and 18th centuries, Prince Bishop Melchior Otto Voit von Salzburg and Prince Bishop Friedrich Karl von Schönborn transformed the town's former Jesuit College into a fully fledged university. In honor of these two main supporters, the university still bears their names. After a tumultuous period of secularization and closure during the era of National Socialism, the university was re-opened in 1972.

Over 13.000 students are currently enrolled, taught by 150 professors.

The University of Bamberg is known for its focus on the humanities and the social sciences, economics and business administration. The corresponding two faculties are the largest on campus. They are complemented by the Faculty of Human Sciences and Education and the Faculty of Information Systems and Applied Computer Sciences.



## Welcome to Bamberg

Bamberg is a small yet lively university city. Its unique Old Town, which is more than 1000 years old, was added to the UNESCO list of World Heritage Sites in 1993.

It is easy to feel at home in Bamberg. The city boasts outstanding architecture with a combination of medieval, baroque and modern styles. Many of these historic buildings are used by the university and its departments. Bamberg's comfortable size creates a personal and hospitable atmosphere conducive to socializing and networking.

The quality of life in Bamberg is exceptionally high. The city is home to numerous cultural institutions such as the Bamberg Symphony Orchestra, the Internationales Künstlerhaus Villa Concordia (International Artists' House) and the E.T.A. Hoffmann Theater, as well as annual cultural events such as the "Magical Weekend" street fair (Bamberg zaubert) and the Short Film Festival.

With regard to outdoor get-togethers, the city's famous beer gardens, the university's summer party or the annual fair in the old town are well worth a visit. For those interested in hiking and other outdoor activities, the numerous nearby nature reserves such as the Franconian "Little Switzerland" and the Steigerwald and Hassberge Nature Parks offer countless recreational possibilities.
