

Dear colleagues,

On 16 April, the Bavarian state government once again extended its imposed curfews and movement restrictions until and including 3 May 2020.

For the University of Bamberg, the policy of reducing on-site presence to a bare minimum therefore remains in effect. The measures detailed in my previous emails (most recently from 31 March 2020, <https://www.uni-bamberg.de/fileadmin/uni/verwaltung/presse/Dateien/Corona/Verlaengerung-Ausgangsbeschraenkung-Staatsregierung-ENGLISH.pdf>) concerning working from home, working on site with employment confirmation certificates, recording working time etc. also remain in effect for the duration of the imposed restrictions (until and including 3 May 2020).

The option of being released from duties in order to care for children remains possible under the previously detailed conditions until further notice. Should the state government make any changes concerning this matter, I will inform you immediately.

As already announced, the summer semester lecture period will begin with network-based teaching on the regular starting date of 20 April.

Despite the state government's fortunate announcement of an initial, cautious easing of restrictions on public life, I urge you to continue to exercise caution and take good care of yourselves.
