

Dear colleagues,

As I informed you in my email of 30 March 2021, we intend to provide a coronavirus self-test once a week for those staff working on site at the university. These tests can be administered on the premises. Unfortunately, the State Ministry has not yet provided us with the necessary testing materials.

The option to take an additional rapid test – in addition to the so-called "citizens' test" – once a week at pharmacies or testing facilities will therefore be extended beyond the original date of 15 April until the self-tests have arrived at the university.

In order to receive this additional free test as a state employee, you will need to show a certificate verifying that you work on site for the Free State of Bavaria. As the form attached to the email of 30 March 2021 can no longer be used due to its limitation to the period ending 15 April 2021, please find an updated version attached here.

If you would like to continue to take advantage of the rapid tests offered by the state, please complete the amended form and have this signed by your immediate superior as described in my email of 30 March.

As soon as the self-tests are available at the university, we will inform you in detail about how and where you can obtain them.
