Dear colleagues,

In my email of 30 March 2021, I informed you that as part of the testing concept for employees of the Free State of Bavaria, self-tests would be made available free of charge once a week in stage 2 for employees working in on site. **In the meantime, the number of tests was increased to two per week.**

All employees working on site will have the opportunity to receive a self-test from the university twice a week beginning on Tuesday, 4 May 2021.

To obtain the self-tests, you can select a convenient distribution point near you and make an appointment electronically. The appointment can be made starting Monday, 3 May 2021. We will inform you separately about the link to be used for this purpose via a message from the Personnel Department. This letter will also provide you with all further information concerning the collection and use of the tests.

Due to the economically favourable test kits allocated to us, we can provide you with a set of five tests at a time, which you can use flexibly according to your needs. If you do not wish to take the test at your workplace or at home, we will provide a central room at Kapuzinerstraße 20/22 room 02.08 (Alter Senatssaal). In the event that you require a certificate verifying a negative result, this can be issued to you upon request. In the event of a positive result, please inform your supervisor as well as Ms Ziegmann from the Safety Office, go home and make an appointment for a PCR test with your general practitioner or with the public health authorities.

You will also find information detailing the complete procedure in the letter from the Personnel Department.

Please regard this opportunity to conduct the weekly rapid tests as a building block for corona prevention, but continue to observe all other applicable regulations and measures including maintaining appropriate distancing, observing hygiene, wearing a mask and ventilating your workplace.
