description The desire to understand business cycle fluctuations, trade interdependencies and comovement has a long tradition in economic thinking. From input-output economics to business cycle theory, researchers aimed to find appropriate answers from an empirical as well as a theoretical perspective. This thesis theoretically and empirically examines how the production structure of the economy as well as industry- or firm-level idiosyncratic shocks contribute to aggregate fluctuations. Moreover, it is analysed how economic shocks transmit and propagate throughout the production network and which policy implications may be derived from the results provided. Furthermore, amplification effects of global economic growth resulting from the underlying network structures are analysed.
